They will gain expertise in managing occupational health and safety initiatives, preparing for audits, and leading teams to foster a culture of safety and compliance within the organization.

This course is intended for safety managers, OHS professionals, auditors, compliance officers, consultants, and anyone responsible for implementing or managing occupational health and safety management systems.
