Course Overview

The ISO/IEC 27035 Foundation Course provides participants with a fundamental understanding of the principles, concepts, and processes of information security incident management based on ISO/IEC 27035. This course introduces the framework for effectively detecting, reporting, assessing, and responding to information security incidents, enabling organizations to strengthen their resilience and minimize the impact of security breaches.

What you'll learn?

In this course, you will learn the key elements of information security incident management, including incident detection, analysis, response, and recovery. You will gain insights into the structure and phases of ISO/IEC 27035, understand how to establish an incident management policy, and learn techniques to improve an organization's incident handling capability.

Target Audience

This course is intended for information security professionals, IT staff, incident response team members, business continuity managers, compliance officers, and individuals who wish to gain foundational knowledge of information security incident management. It is also suitable for beginners who are new to the concepts of security incident response.

Pre-Requisites
