Course Overview

The ISO 14001:2015 Transition Course is designed to help professionals understand the key changes introduced in the 2015 version of the Environmental Management System (EMS) standard. It provides insights into the revised structure, terminology, and requirements, equipping participants with the knowledge and skills to successfully transition their organization's EMS from ISO 14001:2004 to ISO 14001:2015. This course focuses on aligning environmental management practices with the new standard while promoting sustainability and regulatory compliance.

What you'll learn?

In this course, learners will gain a comprehensive understanding of the differences between ISO 14001:2004 and ISO 14001:2015. They will learn about the high-level structure (Annex SL), risk-based thinking, lifecycle perspective, leadership roles, and enhanced focus on external and internal contexts. Participants will also acquire the practical skills necessary to implement the changes, update documentation, and maintain continual improvement in their organization's EMS.

Target Audience

This course is intended for professionals responsible for environmental management systems, including EMS managers, compliance officers, internal auditors, consultants, and members of environmental teams. It is also valuable for organizations currently certified to ISO 14001:2004 and planning to transition to the 2015 standard.

Pre-Requisites

Participants should have a basic knowledge of ISO 14001:2004 requirements and some experience with environmental management systems. Prior auditing or implementation experience with EMS will be beneficial but is not mandatory.
